Rights are rules about how everyone should be treated.

You have rights.

We will help you understand your rights.



Your rights

You have the right to:

- Choose what you do in your community
- Be safe
- Be treated with respect
- Have privacy
- Make decisions about your health
- Protect yourself
- Have someone speak for you if you need help





Children have the same rights as adults.





Your right to make choices about your body and life

You have the right to:

- Make your own choices
- Keep your private life private
- Have close relationships
- Show love and affection in ways that feel right to you



This includes your right to:

- Be close to someone you care about
- Talk about your feelings
- Express your sexuality in safe and respectful ways

No one should stop you from making these choices, unless it is keep you or others safe.
